SALES EXPLODE AT ETI CONVERTING EQUIPMENT

February 5th, 2009 – A great start to a new year for ETI Converting. This Canadian based company manufacturing self-adhesive machines for the label market announces a record, it sold 4 machines in the month of January.

3 machines, 1 Cohesio and 2 Metronomes, were sold to an important group in THE Ivory Coast and Ghana, and the 4th machine, a Cohesio, was bought by a leader in the label and packaging industry in Israel.

February is also looking very promising for ETI, they are in the midst of closing deals with notable companies in Africa and Europe.

With steady price increases for self-adhesive materials, printers are turning to technologies that allow them to reduce their costs and increase their profit margins, and this is where ETI shines, selling over 70 machines worldwide to this effect.

The Cohesio is a progressive machine, it combines the superiority performance of a flexographic press, the Metronome, entirely servo-driven, with the possibility of adding heliogravure stations, silkscreen cassettes or cold and hot stamping unites at any given time, transforming it into a Labeline. This equipment permits printers the possibility to construct a complete self-adhesive label from raw materials, simultaneously attaining substantial savings, realizing ETI Converting's main objective.
